

## Rationales for Practice Paper Responding to Text 2

### Rationale for Response 1 (Outcomes 2.1.2, 2.1.3, 2.1.4)

Score: 4

- Response provides a clear and developed explanation of a main idea from the text.
  - *“As an author, her dilemma is how to not offend her readers and at the same time keep her creative freedom.”*
- Support for the explanation is logical and specific.
  - *“... her responsibility as an author is to please her audience, but at the same time to be able to remain creative and free in her writing.”*
  - *“... she must be certain that it will not offend a reader or strike too personally to somebody who did not give their consent for their story to be told.”*
  - *“She has a responsibility to her readers to respect them and their privacy.”*

### Rationale for Response 1 (Outcome 1.2.4)

Score: 4

- Response provides a clear and developed explanation of how this idea affirms the student’s understanding of responsibility.
  - *“... when one is considering the consequences of their actions, they must put themselves in the place of their victims.”*
  - *“Because the point of this text was to convey the importance of respecting those reading a text you had written, this text affirms my perspective on responsibility.”*
- Support for the explanation is logical and specific.
  - *“While it is likely that if an author chose to write about me it would not be because they wished to harm me, I would still be uncomfortable and feel that my privacy had been violated if I had been written about without my consent.”*
  - *“As an author, one must be careful that what they have written will not affect someone personally.”*
